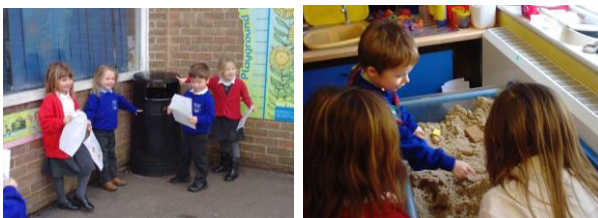
A basket of leaves and a pen will be put in the cloakroom on the classroom notice board so that you can document any other celebrations or achievements as they happen.

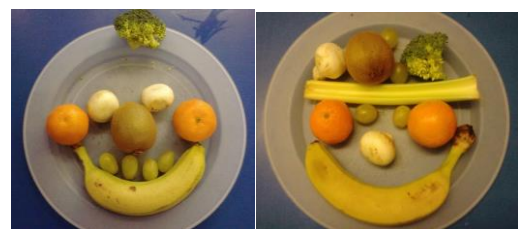
SMIRFS
