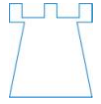

Dinner Money

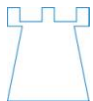
Dinner money for the term will be £71.40. Remember you can pay online with Parent Pay.

Castle Club

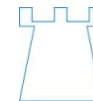
Castle Club booking forms are available from the school office. We also accept childcare vouchers!
