Children have the opportunity to learn biology, chemistry and physics.



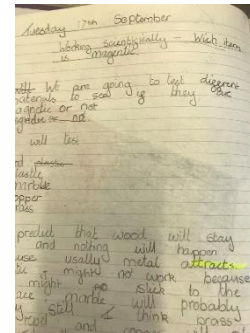
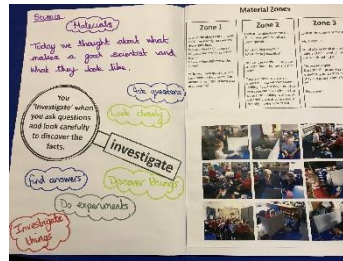
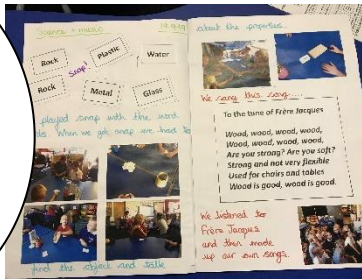
Eureka! Biology – Human body



We enjoy educational visits, which help to extend our science knowledge.

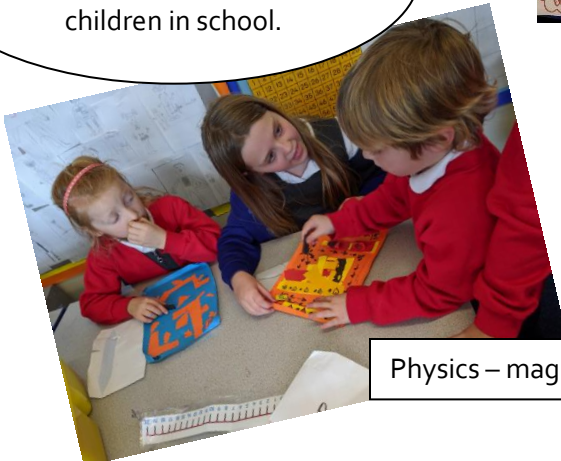
'Working scientifically' is embedded throughout the curriculum.

We use a range of methods to record our scientific understanding



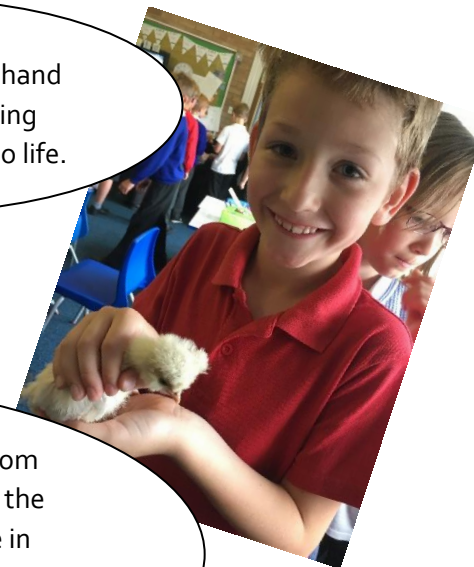
Physics – Earth, Sun, Moon
