What is it like to learn RE at Sheriff Hutton Primary School?

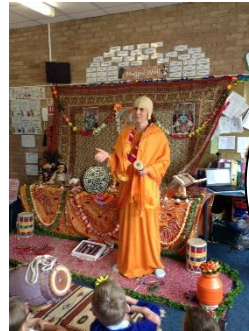
Religious Education is taught through discrete lessons and themed days. We follow the North Yorkshire Agreed RE Syllabus 2019-2024.
